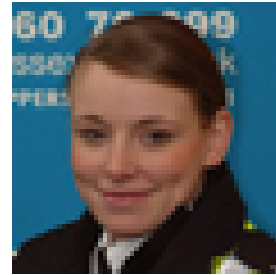

BURGLARY

3/5/09 – Ditchling rd – Broke through rear door of dwelling, damage caused, no entry gained.

3/5/09- Waldegrave rd –Entry through front door, stole television.

4/5/09- Stanford Ave- Entry through insecure rear door, stole video equipment.

9/5/09 – Chester Terrace- Forced window at front. Nothing stolen.

9/5/09- Chatsworth rd – Entered front door. Stole jewellery, photo equipment and computer equipment

19/5/09 – Rugby rd- House unoccupied. Elderly occupant in hospital. Instrument used to gain key. Entered via front door stole property and left leaving door insecure.

VEHICLE CRIME

4/5/09 – Cleveland rd- Mazda door dented during protest march

4/5/09 – Cleveland rd – Broke and dented door, protester pushed into mazda, cause damage

9/5/09 –Rugby rd – Nissan Micra, damage to rear window

18/5/09- Preston pk ave – Superglue in ignition of motor cycle

19/5/09- Hollingbury rd – Whilst under influence caused damage to citroen. Window broken.

19/5/09- Hollingbury rd – Whilst under influence, body force used on wing mirror of Peugeot

20/5/09- Lowther rd – Instrument used to bend handlebars of motor cycle

21/5/09- Springfield rd – Physical force used to damage wing mirror on vehicle

27/5/09- Ditchling rd – Broke wing mirror on car.

27/5/09- Ditchling rd – Physical force, broke wing mirror on car

27/5/09- Hollingbury pk ave-Vauxhall windscreen wipers damaged

29/5/09- Preston pk ave – Car wing mirror damaged.

Crime prevention message

On first looking at the vehicle damage above, it appears that a lot of wing mirrors have been broken. An idea may be for those that can, push your mirrors in when leaving cars parked. It is sometimes temptation with offenders to act if more prominent. Remember also to keep everything out of sight that is of value, and **DON'T** leave house keys on easy access, keep them away from window and doors, where they can be fished out.
