The answer to each question is the name of a country or countries. The countries included in the quiz are listed below. Each country is the answer to only one question, so you might like to cross them off as you go.

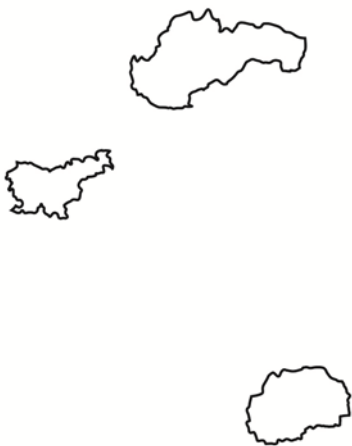
